The uniquely charming natural beauty in and around Boppard and the many reminders of the area's cultural past bring to life its varied historical epochs. Boppard is the lively focal point of the Upper Middle Rhine Valley, a UNESCO heritage area. The quality vintages from Boppard's Hamm wine district, the largest such continuous area on the Middle Rhine are justifiably renowned. You'll discover a wealth of historical treasures in the city centre; especially noteworthy are the Roman fort and the Late Romanesque St. Severus Church, giving Boppard an almost Mediterranean aspect. Interesting half-timber houses alternate with stylish villas from the time of the new Rheinromantik. Centrally situated between Coblenz, Frankfurt and Cologne, Boppard is an ideal base for outings throughout the region.

HIKING IN THE HAMM WINE DISTRICT

Come to Boppard and enjoy your stay in our three-star hotel directly on the Rhine. Gain insights into the vintner's art with a hike through the nearby Hamm district. During your two-day stay you'll visit one of our top vintners and be treated to some of his finer vintages. You can also enjoy spectacular views during a cable-car ride to Gideonseck and Vierseenblick, two outstanding viewpoints. As an alternative, you might try the more demanding climbing path right here in Boppard.

- Two nights with half-board in a lovely three-star hotel right on the Rhine
- An informative guided tour of Boppard's Hamm vineyard district
- First wine-tasting at one of Boppard's top vintners with six regional wines
- Guided tour of Boppard
- Second wine-tasting, again with a leading vintner and six fine wines
- (Depending on group interest, a climbing outing, a cable-car ride or a tour of the UNESCO heritage area can be organized.)
